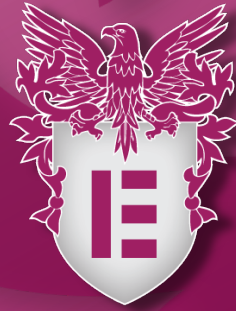

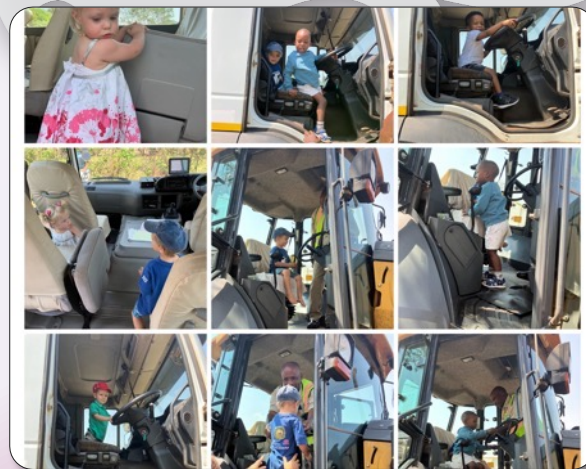

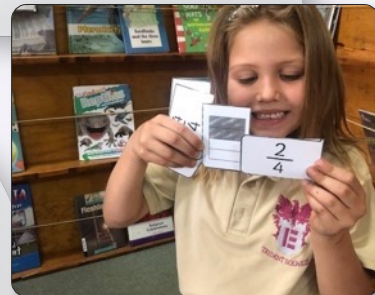
Role Play:

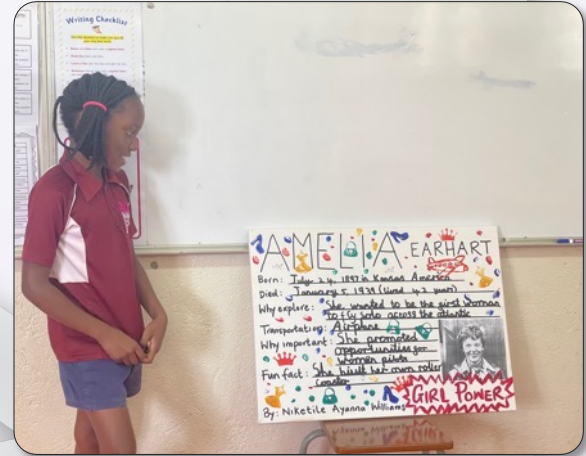


Year 3
