# Art

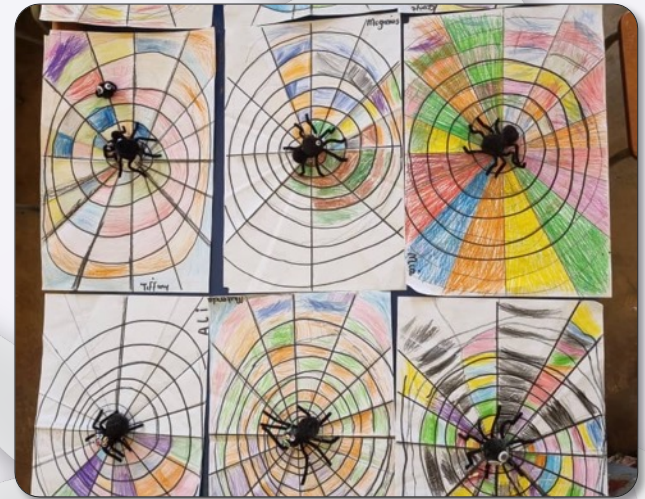
Year 5 was inspired by Remiro Beritto from Brazil. Pop Art with bright colours and solid lines.
