




Our week in Year 1 was awesome! We had special visitors and the Zookeeper was not happy that we made her Tiger











Wow week 3 has been a busy one! In ICT we continued to do our Space Explorers research.




Art

Year 2 worked on drawing a spiral eye teaser. We added big black spiders for fun. Nursery worked on building castles. Shape recognition and texture were our key elements.



Right: Reception and Nursery introduction to ball skills: Throwing, Catching, Rolling and Bouncing.






